

**Patient meets First Responder Activation Criteria**

or

**Neurological** – Patient with deteriorating LOC/GCS

**Airway** – Trauma patient requiring aggressive airway or ventilatory management

**Circulation** – Penetrating injuries clinically correlated to unstable patient;

Deterioration of previously stabilized patient; Trauma patient with unstable vital signs; or Traumatic fractures/lacerations clinically correlated to unstable patient

**Best Motor Response** – Traumatic paralysis OR increasing loss of sensation or movement

**Cutaneous** – Complete amputation proximal to wrist or ankle

**Fracture** – Open and/or depressed skull fracture

**Burns** – Trauma with associated burns and potential/existing airway involvement;

Adult burns > 20% TBSA and/or complex facial, hand or genital involvement; or Pediatric burns > 10% TBSA and/or complex facial, hand or genital involvement
