

Paramedic Fly Guide Air Care Activation Criteria

Patient meets First Responder Activation Criteria

or

Neurological - Patient with deteriorating LOC/GCS

Airway - Trauma patient requiring aggressive airway or ventilatory management

Circulation - Penetrating injuries clinically correlated to unstable patient;

Deterioration of previously stabilized patient; Trauma patient with unstable vital signs; or Traumatic fractures/lacerations clinically correlated to unstable patient

Best Motor Response - Traumatic paralysis OR increasing loss of sensation or movement

Cutaneous - Complete amputation proximal to wrist or ankle

Fracture - Open and/or depressed skull fracture

Burns – Trauma with associated burns and potential/existing airway involvement; Adult burns > 20% TBSA and/or complex facial, hand or genital involvement; or Pediatric burns > 10% TBSA and/or complex facial, hand or genital involvement
